Dress Code

Come and support your team with pride and honour. Values which the Arsenal team carry themselves.

If you are seated club level, you may wear your arsenal football shirts and dress casual; however, you are expected to dress with style and sophistication for your VIP hospitality package guests.

To maintain the formal environment, all men are required to wear smart attire. This includes:

- Button-up shirt
- Black tie attire

Ladies are required to wear formal daywear to compliment this expectation.

Away colours are not permitted at club level.





Matchday Information

Hospitality opening hours

Hospitality opens 2.5 hours before kick-off and will close 1 hour after the final whistle.

Dietary Requirements

Should you have any allergies please ensure you check the allergen information at the venue.

Alcohol

The Club reserves the right to refuse alcohol to anyone that may appear intoxicated. It is the ticket holder's responsibility to ensure all guests behave responsibly.

Stadium Smoking Policy

Smoking is prohibited throughout the stadium. The use of electronic cigarettes is also prohibited.

Entry and exit policy

Failure to provide the relevant ticket upon arrival will result in your being refused entry to the Stadium. For safety reasons guests are not permitted re-entry to the stadium under any circumstances.

Matchday Information

Parking

There is no car parking facility provided at The Emirates, but the ground is easily accessible by tube or bus from central London.

Fixture Changes

Dates and times of fixtures are subject to change, sometimes at short notice. Every effort will be made to keep you informed, but we cannot be responsible for changes.

Away fans

If you or any of your guests support a visiting team, please behave in an appropriate manner, and do not make your allegiance known in any way.

Luggage

Due to security reasons large bags are not permitted into the stadium. Do not bring any bags larger than an A4 sheet of paper.

Getting to The Emirates

Tube

Arsenal (Piccadilly Line) is the nearest tube station, around three minutes' walk from the ground. There is no step-free access leading from the station platforms to the station exit

Finsbury Park (Victoria, Piccadilly Lines and Great Northern rail) around a 10-minute walk - should be slightly less crowded. Finsbury Park station is wheelchair accessible and is likely to be the least congested route to the stadium for wheelchair access

Highbury & Islington (Victoria Line, North London Line and Great Northern rail) around a 10-minute walk - should be slightly less crowded. Highbury & Islington station is wheelchair accessible

Train

King's Cross is the main connecting station for national rail and many underground lines. From here you can travel to the ground via the Piccadilly Line (to Arsenal) or the Victoria Line (to Highbury & Islington). King's Cross station is wheelchair accessible .

Overground: alternatively, a short-overground rail journey of one stop will take you to Finsbury Park station.

Coach

Please note that coach parking is only available on match days.

Coach Parking Sites:

Queensland Road and Hornsey Road are the coach parking sites for Emirates Stadium. Supporters will only have to walk a few moments to reach the stadium. Please note that minibuses are not permitted to park at the designated coach parking site.

Bus

Bus is a fast and convenient option with connections passing the ground on all sides.

All Transport for London (TFL) bus routes are wheelchair accessible and have clearly marked priority seats for people with limited mobility. On most buses the wheelchair ramp is positioned at the exit door and there is one wheelchair user place on each bus.

Main bus stops are located on Holloway Road, Nag's Head, Seven Sisters Road, Blackstock Road and Highbury Corner.

High frequency services will take you within a five-to-10-minute walk of the ground and direct routes cover much of north and central London.

Car

Supporters are strongly advised not to drive to Emirates Stadium. The ground is situated in a mainly residential area with an extensive Event Day Parking Scheme in operation.

Only car owners with resident's permits will be allowed to park on-street in the designated areas and any cars parked illegally will be towed away.

Matchday traffic information

There are changes to the traffic plans on days when matches are played. This is so the Metropolitan Police Service can safely manage travel to and from the stadium and reduce inconvenience, as far as possible, to people living nearby.
