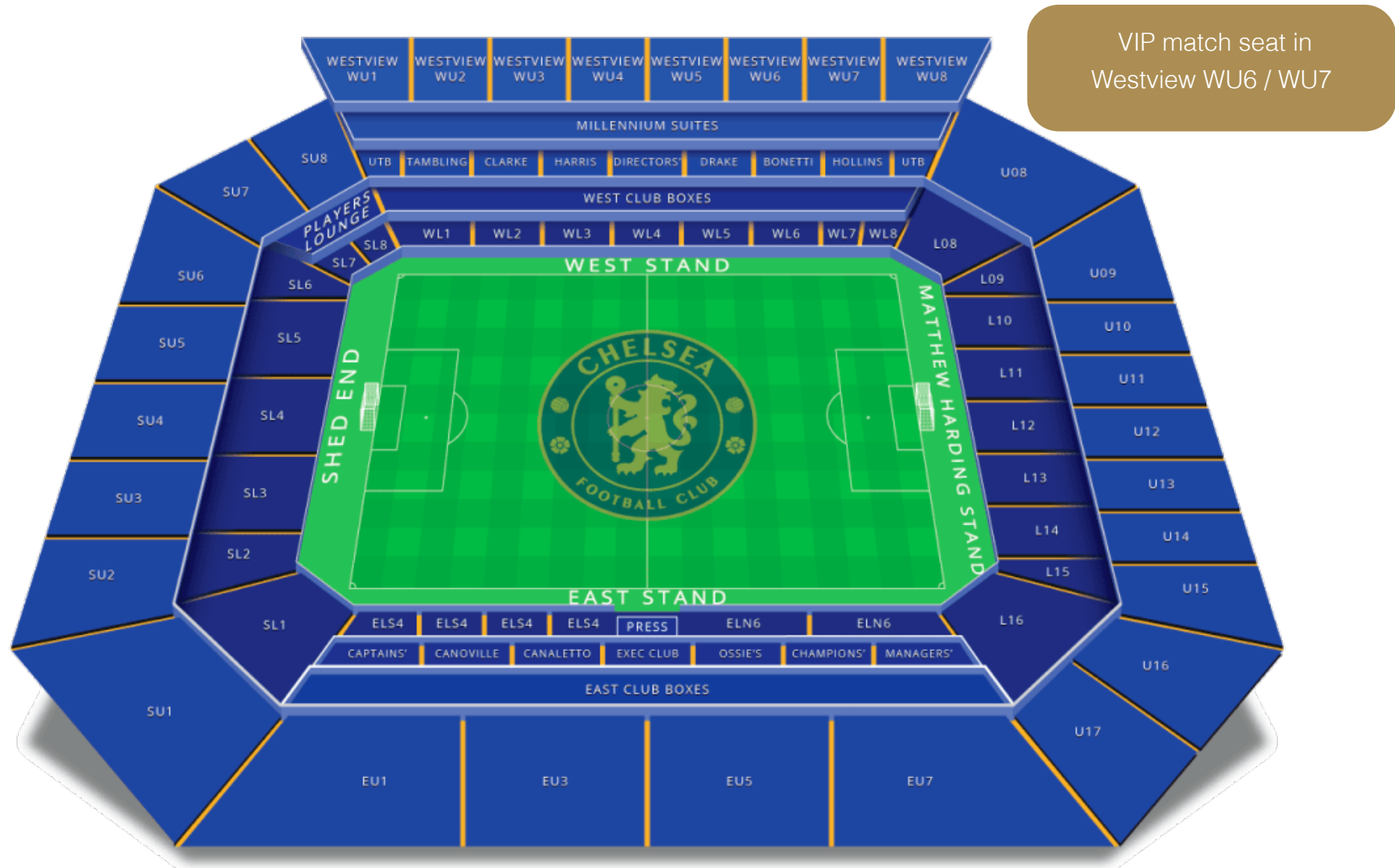

- No away colours allowed
- No tracksuits
- No replica football shirts/jerseys
- These rules are not applicable to children under 12 years old.

**Chelsea Football Club will, if necessary, refuse entry if the dress code is not met.**



# Matchday Information

## **Stadium Entrance**

The Museum suite is accessed via the Millennium reception in the West Stand.

## **Hospitality opening hours**

The suite opens 5 hours before kick-off (depending on kick off time) and will close 1 hour before kick-off.

## **Dining**

The Museum package offers an interactive chef's table, along with complimentary beer, wine, and soft drinks. Savoury refreshments on arrival.

## **Dietary Requirements**

Should you have any allergies please ensure you check the allergen information at the venue.

## **Alcohol**

The Club reserves the right to refuse alcohol to anyone that may appear intoxicated. It is the ticket holder's responsibility to ensure all guests behave responsibly.

## **Stadium Smoking Policy**

Smoking is prohibited throughout the stadium. The use of electronic cigarettes is also prohibited.

## **Entry and exit policy**

Failure to provide the relevant ticket upon arrival will result in your being refused entry to the Stadium. For safety reasons guests are not permitted re-entry to the stadium under any circumstances.



# Matchday Information

## **Parking**

There is no car parking provided at Stamford Bridge, but the ground is easily accessible by tube or bus from central London. Fans are advised not to drive on match days because of parking restrictions.

## **Fixture Changes**

Dates and times of fixtures are subject to change, sometimes at short notice. Every effort will be made to keep you informed, but we cannot be responsible for changes.

## **Away fans**

The Museum is in an area exclusive to home fans. If you or any of your guests support a visiting team, please behave in an appropriate manner, and do not make your allegiance known in any way.

## **Luggage**

Due to security reasons large bags are not permitted into the stadium. Do not bring any bags larger than an A4 sheet of paper.



# Getting to Stamford Bridge



## Walk

Stamford Bridge is on the Fulham Road and is accessible on foot from all directions - a map is advised for those not familiar with the area.

## Tube

The nearest tube station is Fulham Broadway on the District Line. From central London, take a train to Earls Court and change for Wimbledon-bound trains. There are two Overground stations near to Stamford Bridge, West Brompton and Imperial Wharf which are both about a 15-minute walk from the stadium. These are both on a direct line to Clapham Junction station among others.

## Bus

There are two bus stops outside Stamford Bridge on the Fulham Road. Fans can get to the stadium using the number 14, 211 and 414 buses.

## Coach

There is a limited area for supporter coaches in Imperial Road. Imperial Road is now part of the South Fulham Traffic Congestion and Pollution Reduction Zone so access is usually restricted to borough residents and other specially authorised vehicles. Please note that all coaches must be booked onto the system no later than 48 hours prior to the fixture date. Any booking received after this time will be at significant risk of incurring a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).

Chelsea traffic marshals will be able to direct supporters to the ground which is between 10 and 15 minutes walk. If there are fewer than 10 visiting supporter coaches then they will normally, and with the agreement of the police, be relocated during the match to outside the ground in Fulham Road between Stamford Gate and Britannia Gate.

## Car

Fans are advised NOT to drive to Stamford Bridge due to resident parking restrictions in the area around the stadium, especially on matchdays.

Driving from The North, East or West:

Use the M25 to Junction 15 and turn off onto the M4 towards London. Follow the M4 which becomes the A4 up to Hammersmith. Go over the Hammersmith Flyover and a further 1.5 miles before turning off for Earls Court. Go past Earls Court station and across Old Brompton Road, eventually reaching Fulham Road. Turn right at the traffic lights. After 600 yards, the ground is on the right. Parking is difficult very close to the ground.

Driving from The South:

Cross the river at Wandsworth Bridge and head up Wandsworth Bridge Road. At the junction with New King's Road, turn right and then immediately left. This will take you up to Fulham Broadway. Turn right onto Fulham Road and the ground is 400 yards on the left. Parking is difficult very close to the ground.
