By Bus

Shuttle buses will run regularly from Liverpool City Centre (Lime Street and Liverpool ONE) and Bootle Town Centre to Hill Dickinson Stadium. Bus routes 20, 26, 47, 56, and T054 also serve the area.

By Train

Sandhills Train Station is in proximity to the stadium and connects to Liverpool city centre stations, Southport, Ormskirk, Kirkby and south Liverpool. The Club is working with Merseyrail in discussing upgrading Sandhills Station, to cater for the expected rise in passengers on matchdays.

By Car

Liverpool City Council will introduce a 'Football Match Parking Zone' around the stadium. Parking must be pre-booked in advance.

By Taxi

Taxis are available both in the city centre and at the stadium with dedicated taxi ranks and coach parking will be available near the stadium.
