Matchday Information

Stadium Entrance

Travel Club entrance is accessed via the East Stand Atrium.

Lounge Facilities

Spurs Stadium operates on a cashless basis – card payments only.

Hospitality opening hours

Alcohol

The Club reserves the right to refuse alcohol to anyone that may appear intoxicated. It is the ticket holder's responsibility to ensure all guests behave responsibly.

Stadium Smoking Policy

Smoking is prohibited throughout the stadium. The use of electronic cigarettes is also prohibited.

Entry and exit policy

Failure to provide the relevant ticket upon arrival will result in you being refused entry to the Stadium. For safety reasons guests are not permitted re-entry to the stadium under any circumstances.



Matchday Information

Parking

There is no car parking facility provided at Tottenham Hotspur stadium, but the ground is easily accessible by tube or bus from central London.

Fixture Changes

Dates and times of fixtures are subject to change, sometimes at short notice. Every effort will be made to keep you informed, but we cannot be responsible for changes.

Away fans

If you or any of your guests support a visiting team, please behave in an appropriate manner, and do not make your allegiance known in any way.

Luggage

Due to security reasons large bags are not permitted into the stadium. Do not bring any bags larger than an A4 sheet of paper.



Seating Plan

Please note that this package offers three different seating area options

Travel Club Package: BLOCK 236-237 (Behind away supporters – Seating in Level 2 of the East Stand, a reserved premium section with executive lounge access.

Whilst these seats are behind the away seating section, all premium areas are considered the home seating section and any supporters of the away team must moderate their behaviour accordingly.)

Travel Club Package: BLOCK 247 & BLOCK 320 (Spurs fans only – Seating in the East Stand (Level 2/BLOCK 247 – Level 3/BLOCK 320)

Travel Club Package: BLOCK 003 (Overlooking the halfway line – Seating in Level 1 of the East Stand)

Dress Code

Tottenham Hotspur Stadium operates a smart casual dress code.

No tracksuits, sportswear, caps, shorts, trainers (of any variety) football shirts, ripped or bleached jeans are allowed.

The above dress code does not apply to children under the age of 12, we do ask that all children are dressed smartly.

The club has the right to refuse admission to any person wearing clothing deemed inappropriate. Strictly no away colours or offensive clothing.



Getting to Tottenham Hotspur Stadium



Train

White Hart Lane (London Overground): approx. 5 mins walk to the stadium - that's more or less 500 steps for those of you with fitness apps

Northumberland Park (Abellio Greater Anglia services): approx. 10 mins walk to the stadium and about 1,000 steps.

Tottenham Hale (Victoria line and Abellio Greater Anglia services): approx. 25 mins walk to the stadium and roughly 2,500 steps.

Seven Sisters (Victoria line and London Overground): approx. 30 mins walk to the stadium and around 3,000 steps.

Shuttle Buses

The stadium currently provides a free pre-booked shuttle bus service, which is accessible and available for all supporters. This service provides a high capacity, high frequency service between the stadium and Alexandra Palace (Great Northern Services) and Wood Green (Piccadilly Line) stations.

Coach

Tottenham Hotspur operate a Regional Coach Service - in association with Big Green Coach, the Official Transport Supplier of Tottenham Hotspur - to help fans get to and from the stadium on a matchday.

Coach services run from a range of towns in supporter heartlands,

Return coach tickets start from £17 with child discounts available.

Coach travel season tickets for all home Premier League matches start at £289.

All coaches are timed to arrive at the coach park two hours prior to kick-off and depart 45 minutes after full time (or as soon as they are full).

Car

Driving is not advised. A large Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) is in operation and the roads surrounding the stadium are generally closed before, during and immediately after a match.

There is no parking available for general admission fans at the stadium.

The road closures also mean that, if you choose to travel by car, you will not be able to exit any car parking facility within the road closure area for one hour after the final whistle.

Therefore, in most cases, we discourage fans from driving to the stadium, so please explore your public transport options before travelling.

Taxi

Matchday road closures prevent spectators from being dropped-off or picked-up close to the stadium. If you need to use a taxi or private hire vehicle, we recommend you are dropped-off and / or picked-up at least a 10 minute walk (0.5m) away from the stadium.
