## Dress Code

### Gentlemen

### Children

Children aged 17 and under should adhere to the Dress Code, however this does not apply to very young children.





# Getting to Ascot Racecourse

Getting to Ascot Racecourse is a breeze, with excellent rail and road links to this famous racecourse. Ascot Racecourse is perfectly situated in picturesque wooded countryside adjoining Windsor Great Park and is roughly a 50-minute journey by car or train from London. As well as being located close to the M3, M4, M40 & M25 motorways, Ascot is also located close to London Heathrow Airport.

## By Road

From London And The North

M4 Junction 6 onto the A332 Windsor by-pass and follow the signs to Ascot.

From The West

M4 Junction 10 to the A329(M) signed to Bracknell and follow the signs to Ascot.

From The South And East

M3 Junction 3 onto the A332 signed to Bracknell and follow the signs to Ascot.

From The Midlands

M40 southbound, Junction 4. Take the A404 towards the M4 (Junction 8/9). On the M4 head towards Heathrow/London. Leave M4 at Junction 6 and follow the A332 Windsor by-pass to Ascot.

## By Rail

South West Trains also runs a frequent service to Ascot Train Station from both Reading and London Waterloo. The average journey time is 27 minutes from Reading and 52 minutes from Waterloo. Regular services also run from Guildford. The railway station is a seven-minute walk from the racecourse.

A Freedom Pass will take you as far as Feltham en-route from London Waterloo.

## By Lux Transport

Ascot Racecourse has partnered with Zeelo, a luxury travel service that offers unique private transfers to Ascot.

Guests can indulge in drinks and canapes reception from fully furnished leather seats, complete with tables, WiFi and onboard toilets.

## By Air


There is a helicopter landing facility close to the racecourse. It is not suitable for fixed-wing private aircrafts.

The two nearest airfields are Fairoaks, Chobham and White Waltham, Maidenhead, which are both approximately nine miles away.

## By Taxi

We advise booking taxi collection well in advance of the event to avoid disappointment and to miss the traffic.

Ascot Racecourse recommends using Minicabit – a trusted service that licenses Private Hire Operators across the UK. Taxis will make drops at Car Park 3, situated in an ideal spot on Ascot High Street.
