Getting to Sandown Park Racecourse

Car

From London, take the A3 and follow the brown venue signs to Sandown Park. Exit A3 on to the A307 and continue to follow the brown venue signs.

Alternatively, from the M25, exit at Junction 10 and follow the A3 towards London then exit onto the A307 and follow the brown venue signs.

If using a Sat Nav, please enter 'Portsmouth Road' rather than the Sandown Park postcode - this will bring you to our main car park which is just off the A307 (Esher High Street) and is directly in front of the main entrance.

Parking

Parking is free in the centre of the racecourse, which you can reach from the More Lane entrance. Please note that the course will be shut for approximately 10 minutes before and after each race as there will be horses on the course. The entrance/exit will otherwise be open/re-opened.

Coach parking is free - just follow the Sandown Park signposts on all approach routes and park in the area off the Portsmouth Road.

Train

Esher rail station is just a 10 minute flat walk from the main entrance and can be reached by crossing the centre of the course on racedays..

On cold days, frost covers may be on the track, meaning the crossing from the train station into the centre of the course will be closed. Please leave plenty of time for arrival, as the time it will take to walk to the racecourse entrance will be increased. Please be aware updates on frost covers on the track will be updated on the individual event pages.

On a non-raceday, visitors should turn left out of the station onto Station Road and then right at the T- junction to join the A307 Portsmouth Road. The entrance to Sandown Park is on the right hand side.

Please note that Esher rail station is located outside of Zones 1-6 and that Oyster Cards are not valid when travelling to Esher. A paper ticket must be purchased in advance of travelling.

Taxi

There is a taxi rank at Esher rail station.

Air

Sandown Park has a helipad for personnel attending racing only. Please contact us in advance.
